# **About Your Library**

#### History

The Rossville Community Library has existed in its present form since 1950, when a collection of 592 books and magazines (all donated) were housed in the Rossville Community Center.

In 1968 a \$10,000 gift from Sidney and Perry Stumbaugh was matched by federal funds for the construction of a new library. The land for the new library was donated by the Clyde Miller family in memory of early Rossville physicians, Henry H. Miller and Henry B. Miller. As the community and its needs grew, the library built an addition in 1996 that doubled the size of the original building.

Library renovations took place in August 2010 to the older portion of the building. Renovations included a new floor, new paint, and a re-structuring of the main entrance area.

Today, the library provides a broad variety of books, DVDs, audiobooks, seven public computers, 24/7 WiFi, CD/DVD cleaning, fax, copier and printers, Summer Reading Program, monthly story-time, book club, homebound delivery, notary service, voter registration, tax forms, magazines, historical and genealogical materials, and a community garden in its backyard.
